APPLICATION + FEE + IMAGES DUE: April 19th | ARTWORK DROP OFF: May 1st - 3rd

The **OS Retro Exhibit 2024** is for artists who have participated in Open Studios at any time during 2002 - 2023. The exhibit runs from **May 10th - May 31st** with an emphasis placed on Artisphere weekend: the exhibit is promoted in all Artisphere materials and the gallery is open to the public during the **Artisphere weekend hours May 10 - 12**. An exhibit catalogue will be produced and the opening reception will be held **Friday, May 17th, 6:00 - 9:00 pm.**

APPLICATION + DIGITAL IMAGE DUE DATE: The application <u>and</u> a digital image of your work is due **Friday April 19th.** Please email or hand deliver your application + entry fee to MAC (address below), and deliver digital images via email to <u>anna@greenvilleARTS.com</u>. This is a retrospective exhibit so there is no need to create new work unless you want to!

ENTRY FEE: There is a **\$25 FEE** to participate in the exhibit. This money will go towards advertising, the exhibit catalogue and an artists' reception. MAC does not secure sponsorships specifically for this special retrospective. *The money is due with this application. MAC takes cash check (in person or via mail) or credit card (in person or online at greenvillearts.com/artist-fees).*

ARTWORK DUE: Your physical work (ready to hang) will be due to MAC by May 3rd. We will be accepting work from Wednesday, May 1st - Friday May 3rd from 9am - 5pm. A Consignment Agreement form is included in this

packet of information. Please attach it to your work during drop-off. This is a 12x12 (x12) inches Open Studios exhibit - see <u>Artwork Submission</u>
<u>Requirements.</u> The exhibit will run through <u>May 31th.</u>

EXHIBIT CATALOGUE: The OSR Exhibit comes with a catalogue, which will include an image of your work in the exhibit, with details and pricing if for sale, and contact information. (*Pictured here are pages from the 2019 catalogue.*)

ARTWORK SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS


GREENVILLE OPEN STUDIOS 12x12 (x12) EXHIBITS

2-D ARTWORK:

- 2-D pieces are measured by their outer frame dimensions (see graphic):
- Unframed works must be professionally presented, i.e. no unfinished canvas sides with staples showing, etc.
- Screw eyes should be placed near the top of the back of frame so that it will hang properly without leaning out from the wall. Suggested: 2" from top of frame.

• Frames must hang with WIRE on the hook shown here, which is about 1.5 inches tall. Sawtooth hangers do not work with this system!





JEWELRY:

- ◆ Jewelry should be in a 12" x 12" shadow box or displayed on a 12" x 12" base.
- One piece only (earring set is one piece).

3-D ARTWORK:

- One part/side, etc. of a ceramic or 3-D piece MUST measure 12" high or 12" wide or 12" deep.
- No dimension of the 3D work can exceed 12". This means that although you must abide by the 12" one-side rule, the rest of your piece can't be too big.

Examples of how to create/measure a 3D piece:









If you are unsure if your piece fits the above requirements, contact the MAC office at least one week before the exhibit drop-off date to make arrangements to have a staff member or exhibition committee member look at your piece.
